Re: Study of Bill C-11, An Act to Amend the Copyright Act

Dear Glenn Thibeault and members of the legislative committee on Bill C-11 (CC11),

The Documentary Organization of Canada/l'Association des documentaristes du Canada (DOC) appreciates the opportunity to submit this addendum to the Legislative Committee for its Study of Bill C-11, An Act to amend the Copyright Act.

DOC is the collective voice of independent documentary filmmakers across Canada. DOC is a national non-profit arts service association representing over 800 directors, producers and craftspeople in the documentary community, from all provinces and regions of our nation. DOC advocates on behalf of its members to foster an environment conducive to documentary production and strives to strengthen the sector within the broader film production industry.

The enclosed addendum presents our proposal for an exemption for documentary filmmakers to circumvent technical protection

mechanisms for fair dealing purposes. It explains why this is in alignment with the government's public policy objectives and it proposes draft language for consideration by the committee.

Included in our addendum is a letter from the International Documentary Association (IDA). It describes the challenges the American documentary filmmakers faced prior to the creation of a TPM exemption, their successful efforts in obtaining a similar exemption from the US Copyright Office, and the impact the exemption has had on the motion picture industry in the U.S.A.
