The Writers Guild of Canada proposed the following amendment to Bill C-11:

Reproduction for private purposes

- **29.22** (1) It is not an infringement of copyright for an individual to reproduce a **MUSICAL** work or other subject matter or any substantial part of a **MUSICAL** work or other subject matter if
- (a) the copy of the **MUSICAL** work or other subject-matter from which the reproduction is made is not an infringing copy;
- (b) the individual legally obtained the copy of the **MUSICAL** work or other subject matter from which the reproduction is made, other than by borrowing it or renting it, and owns or is authorized to use the medium or device on which it is reproduced;
- (c) the individual, in order to make the reproduction, did not circumvent, as defined in section 41, a technological protection measure, as defined in that section, or cause one to be circumvented;
- (d) the individual does not give the reproduction away; and
- (e) the reproduction is used only for **THE** private purposes **USE OF THE PERSON MAKING THE COPY.**
