1. Economic Recovery and Growth

Given the current climate of federal and global fiscal restraint, what specific federal measures do you feel are needed for a sustained economic recovery and enhanced economic growth in Canada?

Long-term planning which respects and reflects Canada's social, political and economic realities as well as its traditions. Short-term initiatives must be undertaken within this context. 2. Job Creation

As Canadian companies face pressures resulting from such factors as uncertainty about the U.S. economic recovery, a sovereign debt crisis in Europe, and competition from a number of developed and developing countries, what specific federal actions do you believe should be taken to promote job creation in Canada, including that which occurs as a result of enhanced internal and international trade?

Managed investment which targets sectors which have been hit hardest both in the public (CBC and SRC as examples) and private domains(high tech and automotive as examples).
