## Charity admits responsibility for “Indignity” it performed to child’s memorial

Reed Cowan who was on the advisory board of “WE Charity” and a fundraiser, testified to a parliamentary committee that the school that was dedicated to his son Wesley was later “re-dedicated” to another individual

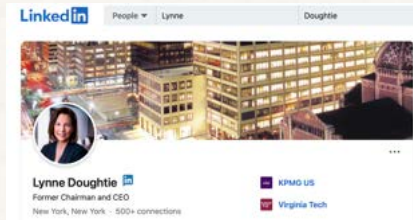
Testimony of indignity to his son Wesley’s memorial

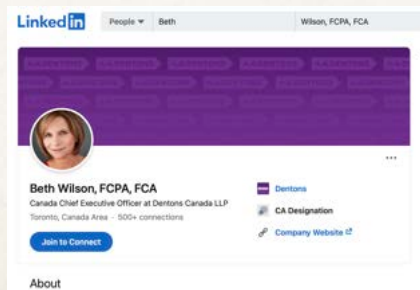

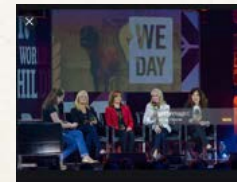

Top brass but "fake" CPA credentials was discovered in 2018 by Alpha Law - An Artificial Intelligence engine developed by investigative journalists Richard Trus and Sydney Eatz, also known as the internet Police.
