My experience with Canada Summer Jobs grants is as follows:
-one year during my 16 years of directing LBC, LBC received one grant.
-the following year, LBC received 3 grants.
This was a huge help to a small camp located within a small town in SK!

Following that, grant applications were submitted but no grants received.
One Hope Canada operates 35 camps within Canada.
One Hope Canada was told that none of our camps would receive grants in the future because the person receiving grants applications in western Canada did not agree with our Statement of Faith/Code of Conduct.

Some One Hope Canada camps in eastern Canada still receive Canada Summer Jobs grants.
LBC has not applied for a Canada Summer Jobs grant since that time.

Luseland Bible Camp is one of One Hope Canada's 35 camps operating across Canada. We exist to present the Gospel, particularly to those having the least opportunity to hear of Christ and especially children and youth, and we disciple believers for living and serving through His Church. Because we follow Christian beliefs and teaching, we are committed to providing an environment free from discrimination and harassment on protected grounds, as protected by provincial legislation. We believe that God created each person in His image, and of equal value in His sight. We believe every person is entitled to equal dignity, respect, and bodily integrity. God loves us all equally and we strive to pour love and care into each person who connects with One Hope Canada.

This has been our experience with Canada Summer Jobs grants.
