## <u>SUBJECT:</u> Production Order to GCStrategies regarding the ArriveCAN Application

Dear Mr. Cardegna:

I am writing further to my November 25, 2022, letter respecting the documents that the Standing Committee on Government Operations and Estimates received from GCStrategies as a result of its production order of October 20, 2022.

In that letter, I informed the Committee that, as decided by the Committee, our Office redacted certain information from the documents received from GCStrategies in their original version, and that we would apply the same redactions to the documents in the other official language once the translation was completed.

On December 21, 2022, you informed us that the translation of the documents was completed and granted us access to them. We subsequently noted that two pages were missing in the translated documents, which we ultimately received on January 3, 2023. I can now confirm that we have applied the same redactions to the translated documents.

We remain at the disposal of the Committee should it wish to be provided with more information or require further assistance on this matter.
