This will be particularly important to support agile procurements of complex IT initiatives and their successful achievement of business outcomes	ESDC agrees with this recommendation. At the time of the audit, the governance structure was in development in parallel with the remainder of the Benefits Delivery Modernization (BDM) programme, but not yet finalized. As of February 2021, there is now a finalized and approved governance structure. The program has an effective stakeholder engagement mechanism with documented and communicated roles and responsibilities. The governance functions is undergoing a refresh in preparation for Tranche 1. The revised structure adopts a holistic approach that integrates stakeholders through decision-making bodies, decision-making individuals, and bodies with advisory and assurance roles. Together, the participation of stakeholders across multiple forums ensures that the initiatives have the support they need to move forward and that business outcomes are met.
