
# An Act respecting First Nations, Inuit and Métis children, youth and families


### **NOTICES AND REQUESTS**

- Subsection 20(1) of the Act recognizes the ability to give notice of intention to exercise legislative authority.
- Subsection 20(2) provides the ability to request to enter into a coordination agreement with federal and provincial/territorial governments.
- A total of **75** Indigenous governing bodies (IGBs) have submitted a notice (**53**) or request (**38**) pursuant to section 20 of the Act.
- First Nations: IGBs representing more than **110** communities have submitted a notice or request.
- Inuit: 1 IGB representing more than 5 communities has submitted requests to 3 provinces/territories.
- Métis: 2 IGBs have submitted a notice or a request in 5 provinces.



#### **CAPACITY BUILDING**

- Funding supports Indigenous governing bodies to develop Indigenous child and family services legislation, systems, and programs in preparation for coordination agreement discussions.
- From 2020 to 2023, a total of **\$200,473,704** in capacity-building funding has been disbursed to **223** IGBs or National Indigenous organizations.




### COORDINATION AGREEMENT DISCUSSION (CAD) TABLES

CAD tables provide an opportunity for an Indigenous group, community or people to work with the relevant provincial, territorial and federal governments to determine responsibilities, processes and coordination of services to help ensure a smooth and effective exercise of jurisdiction in relation to child and family services.

There are **20** established CAD tables (16 First Nations, 1 Métis and 1 Inuit).
